In this training, we will cover CARE Act eligibility criteria, including a review of diagnoses, symptoms, functional impairment and other criteria. We will also cover the key points in the CARE Act process where eligibility is applied/reviewed (e.g. report, evaluation).

At the end of the session, participants will have an increased ability to:

- Describe the Schizophrenia spectrum and other psychotic disorders that are CARE Act eligible (and those that are not eligible).
- List the functional impairments related to these disorders and other eligibility criteria that qualify an individual for CARE Act.
- Identify key inflection points for assessing/applying eligibility throughout the process, including the petition, the county report, and the clinical evaluation.

This training is intended for all counties, counsel, judges, county providers, and other stakeholders that are participating in the CARE Act implementation.

The subsequent open-forum discussion is intended only for counties, counsel, judges, and their county providers to ask questions, discuss topics needing clarification, and to share ideas and thoughts among county team members.
